



TWO PRINCIPLES

1. Parents disciple their children

(simplicity of connecting with younger generation. "As with adults do with children")

Isaiah 41:4 - "Who is calling forth the generations from the beginning? I the Lord with the first and last am He"

- If the culture of the Bible is generational, shouldn't our culture be generational?

Psalm 33:11 - His plans are from generation to generation.

Acts 13:6 - "David served the purpose of God in His generation.

- We need to look at the newspaper and the Bible
- Read "Radical Disciple" and mark what God is calling you generation (this is a forward thing and backward of generations past)
- Not surprised that the younger generation does not want to spend time with the older generation - Daphne says, "My generation can be so boring"
- Stay young by hanging out with younger people
